Please note that it is essential that the agreement of nominees is obtained on the form below, and that nominees are able to sign the Charity Commission Trustee Declaration. The Directors of a company which is a registered charity are also known as Trustees.

Members should be aware that, under the Trust's constitution, the positions of Chairman and Vice-Chairman are formally elected by the Board of Directors from amongst their number.
